## What is Jazz (cont.)

Jazz is an <u>original</u> style of <u>American Music</u>. It is a unique <u>blend of many styles</u> of music including <u>gospel</u> music, <u>brass bands</u>, <u>African</u> music, <u>blues</u>, and <u>Spanish</u> music. Jazz incorporates musical notes that are "bent" to create <u>emotion</u> in the music. Jazz bands can be unique in that they create <u>rhythm</u> from a wide variety of instruments. The rhythms can shift and change throughout the song.

### Improvisation Defined

One of the most unique aspects of jazz is improvisation. This is when the music is made up during the song. There is an overriding melody and structure to the song, but the musicians play it differently each time. Usually, each musician gets the opportunity to solo during the song. They improvise during their solo trying out new tricks and ideas to see what works.
